This term our theme is:
The Rainforest

Maths

Year 1 will be learning about place value within 50 before moving on to find the length, height, volume and mass of objects.

Year 2 will be continuing their learning on multiplication and division before moving onto length, height, mass, capacity and temperature.

English

The children will begin the term by writing persuasive letters themed on our current topic, The Rainforest. They will be using persuasive language to convince the reader. The children will then go onto narrative writing based on the text for the term, The Kapok Tree. The children will be working on their sentence punctuation and using conjunctions to link together their ideas.

PE

The children will be starting their preparations for May Day; they will be learning a country dance. They will also be learning to hit, catch and run in their outdoor unit.

Science

The children will be learning to describe the lifecycle of a human and a frog. The children will also be learning what animals and humans need in order to survive, and what they need to have in order to be healthy.

Computing

In computing this term the children will be learning to make their own animated stories.
