Skills

In reading, the children will continue to focus on developing their fluency skills to help develop comprehension skills such as retrieval and inference. In writing, the children will continue developing the foundations of different sentence structures, including using basic punctuation and a range of conjunctions. They will also begin to apply composition techniques to show an awareness of the reader.

PSHE – Relationships

The children will be exploring how our family and friends influence how we act and behave. They will explore how we can deal with conflict in our lives by looking at our support networks. The children will also learn about online safety and how everyone needs to remain responsible, even in the online world.

DT

RE – How do prayer and meditation help with achieving peace?

Children consider the concept of peace and its importance in the contemporary world. They will consider a diverse range of views about questions of what peace means, how places and experiences can create peace and how individuals and members of communities can help to make their world a more peaceful one.
