I can give an example of how May Day is celebrated.	<b>Why are stories special to us?</b> I can name the Christian holy book. I can name the Muslim holy book. I can explain why religious stories are important to some people.	<b>What are the similarities and differences between sacred texts?</b> I can give an example of a sacred text. I can explain why Christianity and Judaism are similar. I can name one difference between the Torah and the Bible.	<b>Whose world is it? Who created it and why should I care about it today?</b> I can give two different viewpoints on how people believe the world was created.
