History

The children will be able explain how and when the Roman Britain era began. They will also describe specific battles and invasions – Julius Caesar, Hadrian's Wall and Boudicca's rebellion. Furthermore, they will learn how Romans have impacted on today's life e.g. straight roads, names of towns and sanitation.

Reading

The children should be reading daily. The children will use their reading journal to keep track of the pages they have read as well as noting down the gist, connections, wonders plus any other detail about the text.
