Term 3 2024-25

## Maths

In Year 1 we will build upon our knowledge of place value by reading and writing numbers to 70 both in numerals and words. We will count in 1s and 2s and order and compare numbers. We will then move onto addition and subtraction, learning how to identify missing numbers in a calculation, and how to add a number to the number 10. We will also learn how to make the same number in different ways.

In Year 2 we will start the term by learning about Money. We will learn to recognise the coins, notes and symbols related to money and then find different amounts and solve problems. We will move on to place value, recognising numbers to 150 and counting in 5s, 10s and 3s. Finally, we will move on to addition and subtraction, learning new methods of calculation.

## Science

This term our science unit is called Animals, including humans. We will learn to name common animals and sort them into groups, e.g. reptiles, mammals or amphibians. We will compare the features of animals and learn about their diet. We will end the unit by learning to name the main parts of the human body.

## English

We will start the term with a fiction unit, learning the story The Snow Queen. We will focus on using description in our writing and learning how to use similes and alliteration. At the end of the term, we will start our non-fiction unit Amazing Aliens, where we will learn how to write information reports. We will focus on factual writing using sub-headings. We will continue to have a weekly spelling lesson. Please help your child to learn their spellings at home so that they can apply them in their day-to-day writing in school.

## Geography

This term we are learning about the Amazing Amazon Rainforest. We will begin by locating South America and Brazil on a world map and then we will find out about the features of the rainforest. We will learn about the different layers of the rainforest before comparing The Amazon Rainforest to London. We will end the unit by learning about the importance of looking after the rainforest.

## RE

In RE, we will be learning about the features found inside a Christian church and inside a mosque. We will learn about the events which take place in both of these places of worship and compare them to see how similar and how different they are.
