

RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO ACTIVITY ISLAND, ISLE OF WIGHT

KIT LIST 2018

No special clothing is required. Please note that this is only a guide for you to use, but the items in bold must be provided!

- **Suitable nightwear**
- **Underwear**
- **Socks (over ankle length for tree climbing)**
- 2-3 fleeces or sweatshirts
- T-shirts (including long sleeved tops for protection against the sun and for tree climbing)
- Old trousers/joggers (not jeans)
- Shorts
- Disco clothes
- sunhat
- **Trainers or similar activity shoes**
- Beach shoes
- 1 pair of indoor shoes/trainers
- **Waterproof jacket**
- **Wash bag (toothbrush, toothpaste, brush, deodorant – not aerosol, soap, etc)**
- **Towel for showering**
- Plastic bottle for drinks
- Small bag/rucksack (for daily use)
- Plastic bags/bin liners for dirty and wet items
- Sunscreen and After-sun lotion

Please note that for some of the activities it is essential that the children wear long sleeves and full length trousers, so although the weather may be warm enough for the children to wear cut-offs or shorts, they will need to have trousers and long-sleeved tops in order to complete the activities.

All items should be clearly labelled and packed in a small suitcase, kitbag or rucksack. Clothes on school activity holidays do get well worn so please don't spend lots of money on new ones! Please provide clothing and footwear for all activities which you don't mind getting dirty or wet! As the children will be outside for much of the day, please send them with plenty of layers, as this will keep them warmer than one thick layer, and will allow them to strip off layers if the weather is kind to us!

Also be aware that if clothes get wet we may not have drying facilities, so it is essential that the children have sufficient clothing for each day – just in case the weather is unkind to us!

Children **must not bring** any electrical items or mobile phones with them. If your child wishes to take their own photos, please send them with a disposable camera, but remember staff will be taking photographs during the trip.
