Term 4 2024-25

Maths

In Year 1 we will continue to work on our place value and calculation skills by making the numbers 12, 13, 14 and 15 in different ways. We will also learn to subtract from these numbers and solve problems. We will then move onto statistics where we will learn to sort shapes, combine shapes and create and interpret block graphs and bar charts.

In Year 2 we will continue to learn new calculation methods when adding and subtracting with one- and two-digit numbers. We will then move onto multiplication and division, focusing in particular on the 2x, 5x and 10x tables and the related division facts. Finally, we will finish the term by building on our previous knowledge of fractions, by learning how to find half, quarter and a third of a given amount.

Geography

This term we will continue to learn about rainforests. We will revisit each layer of the rainforest, learning more about the conditions and the plants and animals that can be found there. We will use this to create our own rainforest collage, layer by layer. We will also compare the climate and weather of the rainforest to London. At the end of the term we will write a rainforest report.

Science

This term we will continue our science work on Animals, including humans. We will learn about the lifecycle of a human and a frog and think about how animals change as they get older. We will also learn the basic things that animals and humans need in order to survive.

English

This term we will continue with our non-fiction unit Amazing Aliens which we started at the end of last term. We will learn how to write a report and look at the main features of a report, such as using sub-headings and writing topic sentences. We will end this unit by writing our own report about a mythical creature. Our second unit is a fiction text called *Monkey See, Monkey Do*. This is a beating the monster story where we will learn to describe action, thinking about how verbs can tell the reader more about a character.
