Dear Parents/Carers

## **Year 6 Residential Trip to Longtown Outdoor Centre 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> November 2022**

We are very much looking forward to the residential trip next week and love seeing the children so excited!

The trip is being led by Miss Barr and the accompanying staff are Miss Cooke, Mr J and Mrs King.

On the morning of departure your child should arrive at school at **8.20 am** and enter the school via the butcher's entrance on Hawthorn Road. **Please only enter the school with your child if you need to hand over medication.** Spending money should be in a named purse and should be deposited in the box at the entrance. The coach is scheduled to leave as soon after registration as possible so please do not be late. You are more than welcome to wait on Hawthorn Road to wave the coach off if you wish.

As well as their suitcase or bag children should bring a small rucksack to take on the coach with their packed lunch, a snack, a bottle of water and their inhaler if they have one. No phones, smart watches or electronic devices are permitted on the trip.

Earlier this week we resent the kit list to you – please remember that this list is not exhaustive and it may be worth considering sending in extra items which may get wet, for example socks. However, please remember your child will be responsible for carrying their own luggage so make sure you do not over-pack.

Medication, including travel sickness pills, must be passed to **Miss Barr** on the morning of departure, in a clearly labelled bag or container. (Inhalers should be kept in their rucksack). Clear instructions must be provided about the administration and dosage using the schools medicine form using the link below by the end of the school day on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> November. Any medication that is administered to your child will be reported back to you on arrival back at school on Friday.
