This term our theme is:

Down at the bottom of the garden

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about the numbers 0-20. We will focus on ordering the numbers 0-20 forwards and backwards. We will also focus on the composition of numbers to 10 and finding 1 more and 1 less than a number.

Expressive art and design

This Term we will be looking at recycled art. We will be making our own musical instruments. We will also be exploring clay and playdough and making our own sculptures using both of these

Literacy

This term, we will be learning the story of Jack and the Beanstalk. We will continue to use our phonic knowledge in our reading and writing. We will write phrases and simple sentences and focus on forming all letters correctly. We will learn new vocabulary and use this in our storytelling.

Reading and The Library

Please try and read with your child at least 5 times a week. The children receive a dojo for each read they do at home. They also receive a raffle ticket for every 5 reads they complete. At the end of the term, they then have a chance to win a book in the reading raffle. You must record your child's reads in their reading record.

We will continue to visit the library on alternate Fridays. Please send your child in with their library book on this day.

Understanding the World

Our learning will focus on the garden environment. We will plant seeds and beans, look at the conditions needed to grow plants and compare environments around the world that grow different types of fruit or vegetables. We will also learn about the life cycle of a butterfly in more detail, following on from last term. We will also look at where some foods come from and how they go from the ground to our plates.

Physical development

Our PE lessons this term will focus on manipulation and coordination, where we will work on our bat skills. We will also be practising our country dancing in preparation for May Day. PE will continue to be on a **Friday**. Please come into school in your PE uniform on this day.
