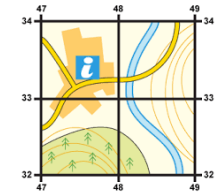
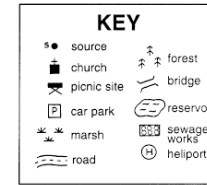

Italian Cuisine
The children will develop a range of cooking and food preparation techniques in including cutting, grating and measuring ingredients. They will be able to explain how the ingredients are grown and processed.

All children will be encouraged to continue practising number bonds and their times tables.



Geography

Children will name and locate the capital cities of the UK, Kettering, seas and oceans. They will learn about physical and human characteristics of a park. They will learn about the eight points of a compass and 4 figure grid references, symbols and keys to build knowledge of a location (Kettering). They will also make comparisons between differing localities including The Grand Canyon, The Lake District and Wicksteed Park.

Science
Plants
Children will learn to explain the functions of roots, stem/trunk, flowers and leaves in a plant. They will learn how water is transported within plants. They will also learn about the process of pollination and seed dispersal.

Reading
The children should be reading daily. The children will use their reading journal to keep track of the pages they have read as well as noting down the gist, connections, wonders plus any other detail about the text.
