KS1 Forecast

Term 5 2024-25

Maths

In Year 1 we will start our second money unit where we will recap the names of the coins and practice adding coins to make a total. We will then move onto place value where we will learn to read and write numbers to 100. We will also recap counting in steps of 2, 5 and 10. We will end the term with our calculation unit which focuses on multiplication by using repeated addition and making equal groups.

In Year 2 we will continue learning about fractions, finding halves, quarters and thirds. We will then move onto Statistics, and learn how to create and interpret pictograms, bar charts and tally charts. We will end the term with our third, place value unit of the year, where children will deepen their understanding of representations of number as well as read, write and order numbers to 200. They will also consolidate their learning of how to count in multiples.

History

In History, we will learn about our local hero Charles Wicksteed. We will find out what he did for the people of Kettering as well as find out what Wicksteed Park and the playground equipment was like in the 1920s, compared to nowadays. We will also learn how to place the building of the park and other significant events on a timeline.

In science, we will be learning about plants. We will recap the parts of a plant and we will find out what plants need to grow healthily and investigate this by growing plants in different conditions to see what happens. We will also learn about deciduous and evergreen trees and common and wild plants.

English

We will begin this term by learning the story of Peter Pan which is a portal story. We will use action and create an action toolkit, using lots of the tools we learnt about last term such as onomatopoeia, verbs and adverbs as well as some new tools like fronted adverbials. The children will then write their own portal story. Later in the term we will move on to non-fiction where we will learn to write a non-chronological report. We will then use this to write about a school trip that we have been on.
