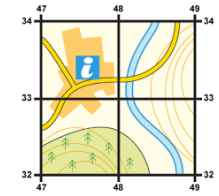
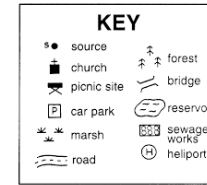

Geography

Children will continue to name and locate the capital cities of the UK, Kettering, seas and oceans. They will learn about physical and human characteristics of a park. They will learn about the eight points of a compass and 4 figure grid references, symbols and keys to build knowledge of a location (Kettering). They will also make comparisons between differing localities including The Grand Canyon, The Lake District and Wicksteed Park. To complete our unit, the children will visit Sywell Country Park.

Reading

The children should be reading daily. The children will use their reading journal to keep track of the pages they have read as well as noting down the gist, connections, wonders plus any other detail about the text.
