KS1 Forecast

Term 6 2024-25

Maths

In Year 1, we will be learning about calculation and will introduce multiplication and division. We will then move on to fractions, finding halves and quarters before learning about mass and volume. In this unit we will investigate the amount different containers can hold. We will also learn about time and telling the time to one hour and half past the hour. Finally, we will look at patterns and relationships and odd and even numbers.

In Year 2, we will continue with calculation by looking at doubling and halving, and then multiplication and division problems. After that, we will move onto money using the 4 different calculation methods to solve problems, before progressing onto mass and volume which will involve measuring in kilograms, grams, litres and millilitres. We will then complete the year looking at patterns and relationships with numbers.

Geography

We will follow on from our work last term on Charles Wicksteed to learn about maps, where Wicksteed Park is located on a map, what human features can be found at the park and learn how to create map symbols and a key to represent these features. We will end the unit by creating our own map of Wicksteed Park.

Science

In Science, we return to our learning of the seasons by looking at Summer. We will observe seasonal patterns in the weather and the environment and will compare this to the previous seasons. We will also learn how the length of daylight hours is longer in the summer than it is in winter.

English

In English this term we will continue to learn the story of Little Red Riding Hood. We will be building a setting toolkit in this unit, finding out how to effectively describe settings in our own stories. We will use commas, adjectives, similes and more to do this. After that, we will move on to our non-fiction unit 'My trip to London' and we will learn how to write a recount using the recount toolkit. We will then write about our own trip using the skills we have learnt.
