## EYFS Forecast Sheet

Term 1 2025

This term our theme is:

Ourselves and Down on the Farm

### Literacy

We will be learning about letter sounds and how they can be used to read and write. We will explore lots of stories and rhymes including The Little Red Hen, where we will learn to orally retell and sequence the story.

### Expressive art and design

We will be learning how to use our new Creation Station where we will explore different painting techniques, junk modelling and malleable resources. We will also be using different stimuli to create our own observational drawings.



### Maths

This term we will be reciting the number names forwards and backwards to 10, matching number names to representations, subitising (instantly recognising up to 5 objects/pictures) and counting different arrangements of objects.

### Physical development

We will focus on developing strength and control in our fingers to help us hold a pencil correctly and write our names. We will also practise moving in different ways, safely negotiating space.

### Library

We will be going to our school library on **alternate Tuesdays** where we will have the opportunity to share stories and choose a book to take home. Please see Class Dojo for details on the dates we will be visiting the library.

### Understanding the World

This Term we will be thinking about what makes us unique. We will talk about our families and people who are familiar to us. We will also discuss our own similarities and differences. We will also learn about different celebrations such as weddings, Diwali, Hanukkah and Harvest. Later on in the term, we will explore Autumn and observe the seasonal changes that happen each year.

PE will be on a **Tuesday** for Cherries and Apples. They will need to come to school in their PE kit on this day. We will let you know on Class Dojo when we will be starting this.

This term our wellbeing focus will be on the British Value of **Community**. We will then continue to build upon our understanding of this value throughout the term.
