Maths

This term in maths all children begin with place value. In Year 1 children will consolidate their learning of numbers from EYFS by counting, sorting and ordering. In Year 2 children will be counting objects to 100 by grouping into tens and learning to partition numbers into tens and ones.

English

In English, we will be using the story of 'The 3 Little Pigs' to inspire their own tradition tale. They will practise writing sentences that begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop. We will also learn to use interesting adjectives. We will then move onto the 'Terrible Troll' which is non-fiction where children will learn to write an information text.

History

In History, the children will learn about the life of significant individuals from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. This term, we will learn about the nurse Mary Seacole who travelled to the Crimea to set up the British Hotel hospital in order to care for sick and injured soldiers. The children will learn about the plants she used to treat their illnesses and how her actions have had a positive impact on nursing today.

RE

In RE lessons, the children will learn how everybody is unique and that these differences are valued. They will learn how different religions (Judaism, Christianity and Sikhism) teach people that they are special and how we can show kindness to help our local community.

Science

The children will learn to name the basic parts of the human body and will think about what their body parts will do. The children will also learn about ways to keep their body healthy, including hygiene and healthy eating.

Art

In art, the children will focus on developing their drawing skills and using different lines to show texture. They will use a range of media and materials and use their observation skills to identify shapes and draw accurately.
