

# How many Bounces can you do in one minute?

On **Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> September and Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September** we will be having a Sponsored Bounce for the children at **Hawthorn**. This is a great event to raise money for the school – it was extremely successful when we ran this last year. A Bouncy Castle will be set up in the playground (or the hall if the weather is poor), and all the children, in small groups, have a turn to bounce.

Whilst the children are having fun, a minute of their 'bounce' is timed and the number of bounces they make during this time will be counted and recorded on their certificate. At the end of their bounce session, they will have a freeze pop to cool down.

Please would you kindly help your child/ren ask their family members and friends for sponsors, any amount is welcome no matter how small. This will be for taking part in the activity. For obvious reasons of safety, **PLEASE DO NOT** let them go knocking on people's doors in the street. Your child will bring a paper copy of their sponsor form home by the end of the week.

Please could all sponsorship forms – and the money raised for taking part be returned to school on **Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September**. All sponsorship money will need to be in cash. All children who raise money for the school will be rewarded with a house point for community.

All the monies raised from this year's bounce will go towards the celebration rewards held at Hawthorn: toast and tales, school values and book raffle afternoon teas, book prizes for the reading raffle etc.
