KS1 Forecast

Term 3 2025-26

This term our theme is: **Frozen lands**

Maths

In year 1 we will continue to learn about shapes (2D and 3D) and position and direction. We will then learn about money, identifying coins and finding different values. We will then return to place value and learn to count to 70 in different ways.

In year 2 we will finish learning about time and finding the durations of different events. We will then learn about fractions, focusing on equal parts, halves, quarters and thirds. We will then learn about shape, focusing on 2D and 3D shapes and their properties. Finally we will learn about money, using different coins and notes and finding the total of different amounts.

English

In English we will be learning the journey story 'The Gingerbread Man'. In this unit we will bake our own gingerbread men and learn to describe them and the other characters in the story. We will then write our own version of a journey story with different characters.

We will finish the term learning instructions and the tools needed to write them.

Science

Our topic is Everyday Materials. The children will explore a range of materials such as wood, metal and plastic, and learn about their different properties. They will then use this knowledge to carry out an investigation

Geography

This term in Geography we are learning about Frozen lands. The children will learn the location of The Arctic and Antarctica and find these on a map. They will explore the conditions of these locations such as the temperature and the weather and how global warming might impact these locations. The children will learn about the physical features of each location and they will also find out about the transport and homes in cold climates and compare these to the UK.

RE

This term we are learning about diversity within Judaism and how Jewish people may live. The children will learn about the Jewish story of creation and the Jewish holy day of Shabbat. They will find out what happens during and after Shabbat and what can be found in some Jewish homes.

Art

Our focus is Sculpture. The children will learn how to roll and shape paper and learn how to attach these to a base to form an imaginative 3D sculpture. They will also work collaboratively to plan and create another sculpture, and use painting skills to decorate it.
