Reading

Book Studies: Plastic Sucks and Charlotte's Web.
During these lessons, the children will be focusing on developing their fluency, retrieval skills and basic inference skills.

Writing

Genre: Information texts and Suspense Story
Toolkit: Information and suspense
We use the Talk for Writing approach which supports the children in developing their writing toolkits. They will develop their skills through short-burst writing, linking to their reading skills, looking at a modelled text and using drama. At the end of each unit, the children write a final draft to showcase their writing skills.

Maths topics this term: Money and Decimals, Place Value

Y4 will be having a xtable focus in their Maths groups.

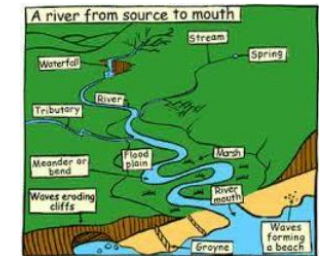
All children will be encouraged to go on TTR for 5 – 10 minutes a day.

Science

States of Matter

The children will learn to compare and group materials based on whether they are solid, liquid or gas. They will also measure the temperature at which materials change state. Children will learn how to explain evaporation and condensation and link this to temperature.

Geography

Children will visit Slade Brook to identify features of physical and human geography which they have covered in their learning. The children will write an information text all about The Amazon River or Yangtze River. They will also write a letter to discuss the use of plastics in our world and the impact it has on our environments.
