Dear Parents/Carers

Year 4 Residential Trip to The Frontier Centre: 11th – 13th March 2026

We are very much looking forward to the residential trip next week and love seeing the children so excited!

The trip will be led by Mr Lewis and Mrs Tinto and the accompanying staff are Mrs King and Miss Bell.

On the morning of departure your child should arrive at school at the butchers gate on Hawthorn Road at the normal time. They do not need to wear their uniform. If you are bringing medication for your child please hand this to Mr Lewis at the butchers gate.

We will be making two trips to the Frontier Centre in the school minibus.

Group 1: 10.30 am

Group 2: 11.15 am

You are more than welcome to come back to wave the minibus off on Hawthorn Road if you wish.

You will be advised of your child's group in a separate communication via MCAS and on the Trip Class Dojo page.

As well as their suitcase or bag your child should bring a small rucksack to take on the minibus with their packed lunch, a snack, a bottle of water and their inhaler if they have one. If you have ordered a lunch from Kingswood Catering this will be delivered to school in the morning.

No phones, smart watches or electronic devices are permitted on the trip.

I am resending the kit list to you with this communication. The kit list is not exhaustive and it may be worth considering sending in extra items which may get

wet, for example socks. However, please remember your child will be responsible for carrying their own luggage so make sure you do not over-pack.

If your child requires any medication, creams/ointments, travel sickness pills, these must be passed to Mr Lewis on the morning of departure, in a clearly labelled bag or container. (Inhalers should be kept in their rucksack). Clear instructions must be provided about the administration and dosage using the schools medicine form using the link below. Any medication that is administered to your child will be recorded in a medical record book.

Clear messages about expectations of behaviour, both inside the centre and during the activities will be given to the children. They will also be warned about the consequences of inappropriate or dangerous behaviour and the risk of them being sent home early! This is a trip that we want all of the children and staff attending to enjoy.

We should arrive back at school in two trips on the Friday afternoon as follows:

Group 1: 1.15 pm approx.

Group 2: 2.00 pm approx.

If there are any delays, updates will be sent to you on the Trip Class Dojo page. Once your child has arrived back at school they can go straight home so please make arrangements to collect them at this time.
