This term our theme is: VICTORIANS
This term our value is: THOUGHTFULNESS

Reading

Book Studies: The Owl and the Pussy Cat (Poem), Son of a Circus (Historical recount), The Barnaby Project (Picture Book), Charlotte's Web (Classic).

During these lessons, the children will be focusing on developing their fluency, retrieval skills and basic inference skills.

Writing

Genre: Recount and Finding and Losing Tale

Toolkit: Recount, Setting, Openings and closings, and Descriptive (retrieval of previous skills)

We use the Talk for Writing approach which supports the children in developing their writing toolkits. They will develop their skills through short-burst writing, linking to their reading skills, looking at a modelled text and using drama. At the end of each unit, the children write a

Maths topics this term: Money and decimals, calculation, length and height, mass and volume, spotting patterns.

Y4 will take their Times Table Test in week 2
All children will be encouraged to go on TTR for 5 – 10 minutes a day.

The children are taught Maths in pure year groups using the Effective Maths programme. They have 5 Maths lessons and an additional fluency lesson per week.

Science - Light

The children will learn that light is reflected from surfaces. They will also be able to explain that opaque objects create shadows. Furthermore, they will be able to explain why shadows change in size at different times of the day.

History

The children will learn about important inventions of the Victorian era and the impact this has today's society. They will also learn about the lives of working Victorian Children. The children will have the opportunity to visit Holdenby House for a Victorian experience day.
