## What is Pupil Premium?

The Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) is a government scheme designed to narrow the attainment gap for disadvantaged pupils in schools in England.

## What does that mean?

More funding in school to support learning.

Free fruit and milk.

Free school meals in KS2

Did you know your child would be given a £100 virtual voucher if you are eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant? This could be spent on many things during the school year.

Extra curricular clubs

School trips

Uniform

Beavers and Brownies

Music lessons

Swimming lessons

If you are in receipt of any of the following benefits you may be eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant.

- Income Support
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance
- Child Tax Credit Only (with income up to £16,190) with no element of Working Tax Credit
- National Asylum Seekers Support
- Guarantee Element of the State Pension Credit
- Employment and Support Allowance (income related)
- Universal Credit (income dependant)
