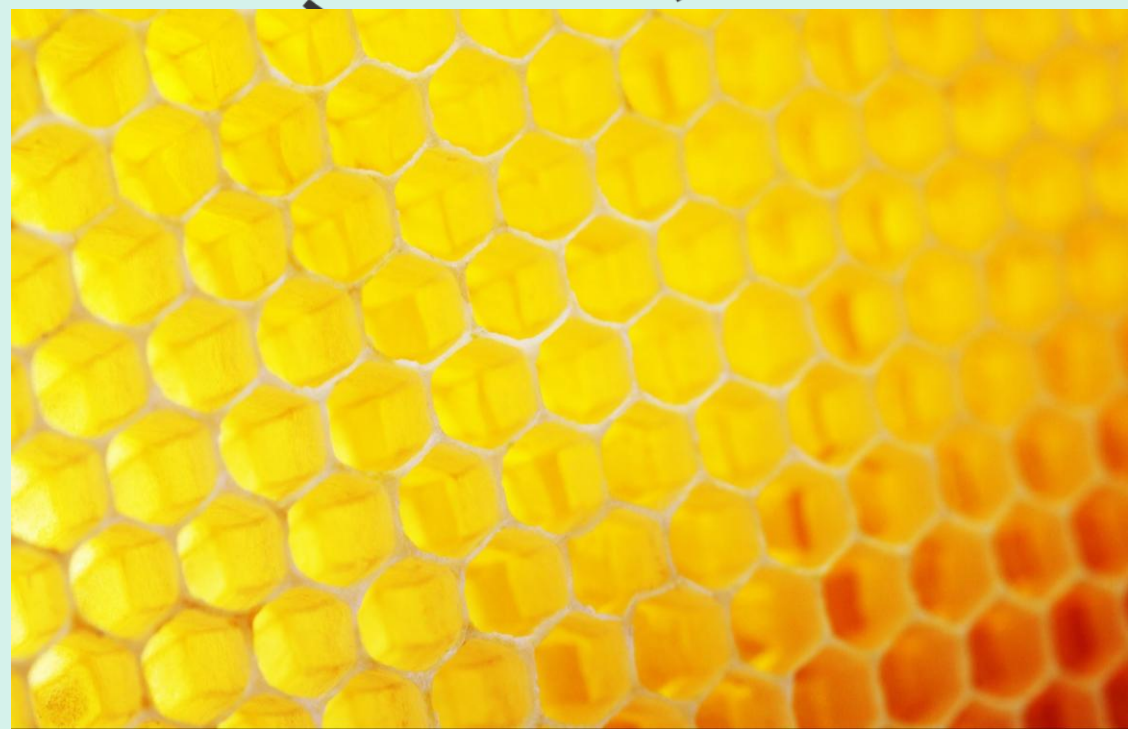
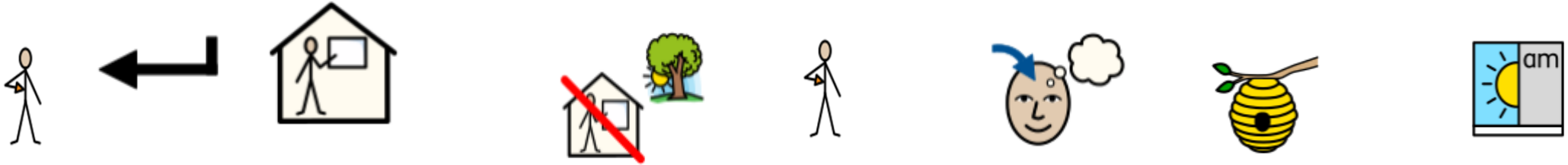


**Welcome to

As well as completing my maths and writing with an adult, I will have Learning and Exploring to do on my own or with my friends. These might be:



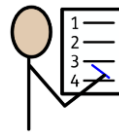
First, when I come into school I will go to sensory circuits in the hall.

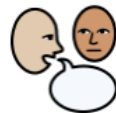
At the end of every day, I will collect my water bottle, bookbag and coat and line up at my classroom door.
