Term 1 2026-27

This term our theme is:
Let's Explore London

Maths

In **Year 1** we will begin by recapping counting and writing numbers. We will practice number formation and simple number facts like number bonds and one more and one less. We will then move on to place value where we will read and write two-digit numbers and begin counting forwards and backwards in twos.

We will learn about calculation and number bonds from 5 to 10 and solve problems with these facts. At the end of the term, we will then learn the related subtraction facts for these numbers.

In **Year 2** we will start with place value, learning to read and write numerals to 100 as well as learning how to partition numbers and represent them on different number lines. We will round off the term by learning to add and subtract a two-digit number and ones.

Geography

We will name and locate the 4 countries of the United Kingdom, as well as the capital cities and surrounding seas. We will use aerial photographs to identify London landmarks and learn about the human and physical features of London.

PSHE: Being me in my world

Music: Call and response (Animals)

RE

In RE we will be learning about the religion of Islam. We will find out that Muslims believe Allah is the one true God and that there are 99 names to describe him. We will also learn of the importance of the Qur'an and how it helps Muslims to lead a good life.

English

We will be learning the story of Goldilocks and the 3 Bears using actions. We will learn about adjectives and verbs to describe our characters and how they move. We will also learn how to open our stories in different ways. We will use all of this to then plan and write our own stories.

Science

We will learn that there are 4 seasons in a year: spring, summer, autumn and winter. We will then focus on autumn and find out what the weather is like and how some trees lose their leaves. We will go on a walk to spot signs of autumn and will find out how some animals prepare for the colder weather which is on its way.

Art

We will be learning how to use clay to make a range of shapes and marks. We will make a pinch pot and learn how to join clay pieces together. We will finish the unit by making a clay house tile.
