Maths

In maths this term, Year 2 children will be learning to recognise and count coins and notes. They will then move onto multiplication and division, using the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. In Year 1 children will be learning to count and order numbers to 20. They will then progress onto addition and subtraction using numbers within 20.

Geography

This term we will be learning all about the Amazon rainforest. We will learn to locate South America, Brazil and The Amazon rainforest on a map of the world. We will then compare the Amazon with London, discussing the similarities and differences. We will be learning about the 4 layers of the rainforest, looking at the conditions of each layer and what animals live there.

This term we will be using the nonfiction text The Rainforest Book.
We will be looking at the features of
a non-chronological report (heading,
sub-headings, questions, facts)
before writing our own reports about
a rainforest animal.
