Dear Parents/Carers,

On **Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> December** the KS2 children will be celebrating their party afternoon. On this day please send your child to school with party food for the communal feast, rather than their usual packed lunch (although you may still wish to provide your child with a mid-morning snack). Please do not order a hot meal for your KS2 child on this day. If they are entitled to free school meals please choose the packed lunch option and this will be added to the feast. (Any hot lunches ordered in error will be cancelled by the school and your account will be credited). Drinks will be provided by the school, but your child should still have their water bottle for drinks during the rest of the day.

The children will all eat their party food in their own classroom, sharing the items that have been brought in by all of the children in the class. For this reason, we do not ask for particular classes to provide one type of food. Please send your child into school with a donation of party food, it could be pizza, chicken nuggets, sausage rolls, cocktail sausages, crisps, savoury snacks, carrot sticks, cherry tomatoes, grapes, biscuits, small cakes, chocolate treats, jam tarts or any other suitable treat!

We hope that each class will have a good selection of sweet and savoury treats to eat, so if you are able to discuss with other parents from the class what you intend to send in this may avoid a class having a thousand sausage rolls to eat but no cakes!

**As we have children with severe nut allergies, could you please ensure that no nuts or nut products including Nutella are included.**

During the morning of their party day, all of those children who have booked tickets will be visiting the Lighthouse Theatre to watch the morning performance of Cinderella. The children will walk down to the theatre after registration and will then walk back to school ready for lunchtime after the end of the performance. Any key stage 2 children who are not attending the pantomime will remain in school. Children should wear their usual school uniform on this day, as it is much easier to keep track of the children at the theatre if we know that they are wearing their uniform; but they may bring a change of clothes for the afternoon party if they wish.
