Homework:

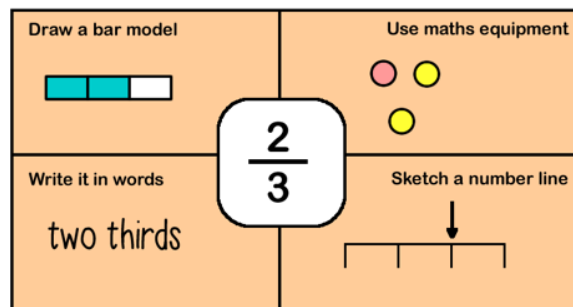
Choose a different river to research and write a simple report on. This only needs to include an introduction to introduce the river and choose one feature to write a subheading and paragraph about.

Extension:

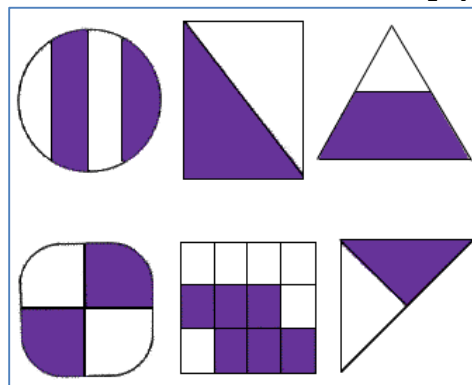
Complete the full report including different paragraphs and subheadings on different features of the river and a 'Did you know?' box which gives some facts you have discovered.

Maths: This week the children have started to investigate fractions. We have looked at what a fraction is: an EQUAL part of a whole and how to represent in different ways. This has included: in words, symbol, on a bar model, as a quantity, on a numberline and of different shapes.



Homework: Choose a selection of fractions to represent in different ways. E.g. $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{5}$

Extension: Which are showing $\frac{1}{2}$? How do you know?
