Thank you for taking the time to complete the parent survey that we sent to you in January. We have analysed the results and would like to share with you the key messages.



Good news stories

86% would recommend your child's school to another parent

Of those pupils who have a special education need 92% said their school gave them the support they needed to succeed

87% said that your child feels safe at the school they attend

Areas you would like us to develop

11% felt that pupils were not well behaved

11% would like schools to offer further support for their child's wider personal development

13% would like more information about what their children learn

What next?

Pathfinder Schools will be supporting all its schools to analyse their results. Your child's school will give you similar feedback including the actions they will be taking to address the areas that have been highlighted at school level.

Pupil Behaviour

This is something that we have asked schools to feed back to you individually as it is school specific.

Information about what your children learn

All schools are currently conducting a website audit. This includes looking at the curriculum information available on websites for parents in order to ensure that you have information about what your children are learning and ideas on how you can support your children with their learning at home.

As a Trust we will look across our schools to see what information is given to parents, highlighting areas of good practice and enabling us to learn from one another.

Wider Personal Development

Pathfinder Schools offer a wide variety of sporting activities and tournaments between the schools giving our pupils fantastic opportunities to participate in events with the Pathfinder Schools community.

We are currently forming a Pupil Parliament including representatives from all our schools. One of their first jobs will be to look at the personal development opportunities we offer and how we can extend these across the school community to ensure they are accessible for all pupils.
