### Our learning this week

#### Class information

This week we have been looking at the story of Hansel and Gretel in literacy. We have been writing character descriptions of the witch and creating our own maps to help us find our way around school. We have enjoyed using the orchard to explore the artist Kandinsky and how he used colour and shape in his art. We have been using our sense of touch to build words blindfolded using magnetic letters, then deciding whether it is a real or alien word by sounding it out.

#### This week's homework

We have started looking at the numbers 10- 20 in maths, learning to count up to 20 and form the numerals correctly. We have also looked at different ways to represent the number with numicon, objects, numerals and so on.

The homework this week is to pick one activity from the home learning sheet and practise the formation of the numbers 11-20. You may want to record this in your books with photos, drawings or a little comment to let us know what you have enjoyed doing.

#### Handwriting

It is important that good habits with correct letter formation are developed straight away as bad habits are very difficult to correct as the children move through the school. In the box to the right we have written a letter that your child is finding particularly difficult. Please practise the **correct formation (refer to the little green books)** at any opportunity. This can be in any way that appeals to your child, eg. 'writing in the air', in chalk, tracing it in a tray of rice or writing on paper.
