## English

We will look at the text 'Here We Are' by Oliver Jeffers focussing on writing labels and simple sentences, followed by reading 'Mrs Armitage on Wheels' by Quentin Blake which we will use as our inspiration for our own stories.

Place value of numbers involving counting and ordering numbers, finding 1 or 10 more and less, number bonds to 10, 20 and 100 and simple addition and subtraction skills.

## History

The invention of the motor car, aeroplanes and trains and how transport has changed over time and has shaped our lives.

We are also looking back over the lifetime of the school, in particular focussing on the early days of Hawthorn up until the late 1930s, in order to celebrate Hawthorn's 125th birthday! This forms part of the wider whole school celebrations!

## Science

**Everyday Uses of Materials** - naming and describing different materials and their properties; discovering what materials are used for and why; exploring how some materials can change shape and learning about Scottish inventor John McAdam and his invention of tarmac which has impacted our lives today. We will also take part in investigations relating to the suitability of different materials for different purposes such as the best surface for a car to run on.
