## Maths

In maths, we will be continuing with our work on fractions which we just started before Easter. We will then move onto multiplication and division and then finish the term by measuring length, mass and capacity.

## Geography

In Geography, we will find about rainforests and where they are situated around the world. We will focus in particular on the Amazon Rainforest in Brazil. We will learn about the flora and fauna which makes up this incredible environment and compare it to a British woodland, discussing the similarities and differences. This topic also complements our art work this term as we will be looking at the work of French artist Henri Rousseau and his imaginative artwork which he set in a jungle.

## English

We will read the story 'The Great Kapok Tree' by Lynne Cherry which is set in the rainforest. The story encourages discussion on the care of the rainforest as a habitat for all of the wonderful creatures which reside there. The children will use this as an inspiration for writing their own stories set in different forests.

We will be reflecting upon why our world is so special. We will discuss natural wonders of the world and the impact humans have upon the environment and how we can best take care of it.

## Science

Our topic is based around plants, naming their main parts and finding out about their functions. We will take part in investigations to find out suitable growing conditions for bulbs and seeds to grow into healthy plants. We will also bring in our mathematical skills by measuring and recording the heights of the seeds we grow, at regular intervals across the term.
