Dear Parents and Carers (children in EYFS to Year 5)

In term 6, the children will start to focus on the “Changing me” puzzle piece from the PSHE Jigsaw scheme we use at school. As in my previous letter regarding the relationship and sex education element of PSHE, we have ensured that the statutory requirements are covered within this scheme we use.

Due to school closures last year, the children will not have covered this unit from their previous phase. Therefore, this year, the children will be taught the units in pure year groups, allowing us to have a continued progressive curriculum moving forwards. This will ensure that vocabulary and terminology is age appropriate, building on the children’s prior knowledge. Here is an overview of the year group lessons which will be taught:

EYFS – Changing Me unit

KS1

Year 1 – EYFS Changing Me unit

Year 2 – Year 1 & 2 Changing me unit

LKS2

Year 3 – Year 2 Changing Me unit

Year 4 – Year 3 & 4 Changing Me unit

UKS2

Year 5 – Year 4 Changing Me unit

Year 6 – Year 5 & 6 Changing Me unit

Following this structure, it will allow the children to be taught in mixed year groups again next year as the terminologies missed will have been covered this term. This format of two PSHE cycles is used due to the mixed aged year groups we have at Hawthorn.

If you would like a breakdown of the lessons that your child will be covering, please contact your child’s class teacher via Class Dojo as they will be able to send you the overviews of the lessons and address any questions you may have, or you can email the office and ask to speak to me and a phone call can be arranged.
