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

Kettering library is open for business, but the way you access it is a little different from normal. Here is some information from Kettering Library explaining how to access the building and collect things for the Summer Reading Challenge:

*Kettering Library will be reopening with limited services on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> July so if anyone wishes to participate in this year's Summer Reading Challenge and take books out from the library, they can book a browsing slot to come in and a member of staff will issue them with all the necessary resources. Customers can book with us by emailing [kettering.libraryplus@northnorthants.gov.uk](mailto:kettering.libraryplus@northnorthants.gov.uk) or they can call the North Northamptonshire Council customer service centre on 0300 126 3000 (option 5, then option 1) and book over the phone.*

*We will also be offering an information service on the door at the library so if anyone just wants to sign up to the Summer Reading Challenge, they can come to the library between 10am and 4pm Monday to Friday and a member of staff will speak to them.*

*All our Summer Reading Challenge activities will be conducted online this year and posted to our social media pages. Due to the GLaM project building work, we have limited space in the library so we unfortunately cannot offer in-person activities at this juncture.*

Thank you so much for supporting your child with their reading. We all know just how important reading is, and the Summer Reading Challenge is just one way to engage and excite your child. In fact, you could do the challenge as a whole family. I wonder how many books you will all read!
