Maths

History and Geography

In history we will be learning about pirates and how they lived. We will explore their clothes, what they ate and we will learn about the parts of the ships they sailed in. We will also learn about the four compass points and how pirates used these and maps to help them to know where they were going! We will then learn about maps and map symbols before moving on to creating our own maps.

Our unit is called 'Caring for others'. We will be exploring religious festivals and stories and seeing how people care for one another.

English

We will start the term with the story 'The Enormous Crocodile' to celebrate Roald Dahl Day on Monday 13th September. After that, our focus will be instruction writing, and we will be using the book 'Pirates Love Underpants' as a hook for our instruction writing. The children will continue to do daily phonics sessions in groups.

Science

Our topic is based around our bodies and our 5 senses. We will be learning about the basic body parts and naming them as well as exploring each of our 5 senses and how they link to our body parts.

This term our theme is portraits. We will be drawing a self portrait before turning it into a pirate portrait!
