This term our theme is:

Animals and their environment

Maths

In Maths, we will be learning about the numbers 11-20 and their composition. We will focus on ordering the numbers 0-20 forwards and backwards. We will also focus on our spatial reasoning skills. This will involve completing jigsaws and puzzles. We will think about selecting and rotating shapes to fill a given space.

Computing

This term we will be using programmable toys to explore position and direction. We will also be learning how to login to Purple Mash independently.

Expressive art and design

This Term we will be looking at recycled art and printing. We will study the work of Maya Lin and Elizabeth Catlett. We will apply the skills we have learnt so far to create our own pieces of art, music and movement.

Understanding the World

This term we will be learning about animals and their environment. We are looking forward to our visit to Hamerton Zoo where we will find out about lots of different animals, where they come from and how they adapted to the environment in which they live. We will make comparisons between life in our country and life in other countries and the similarities and differences between the different localities.

Literacy

We will continue to use our phonic knowledge in our reading and writing. We will write phrases and simple sentences and focus on forming all letters correctly. We will learn new vocabulary and use this in our storytelling.

Physical development

Our PE lessons this term will focus on manipulation and coordination, where we will work on our bat skills. We will also be practising our country dancing in preparation for May Day. PE will continue to be on a **Friday**. Please come into school in your PE kit on this day.
