Maths

In maths this term both year 1 and 2 will be learning about money. Year 1 will be learning to recognise coins and notes and add small amounts together. Year 2 will be selecting the correct coins and counting amounts correctly.

History and Geography

This term we will be looking at the Arctic. In geography we will use a range of maps and globes to identify where in the world it is, before comparing the Arctic to Kettering. In history we will be looking at the explorer Matthew Henson and his exploration to the Arctic. We will compare his exploration to other Arctic missions, looking for similarities and differences.

English

Our text for this term is 'The Great Explorer' by Chris Judge. We will be making predictions about the text and look at the vocabulary the author has chosen. We will also go on to write our own story using the text as a guide. For our grammar focus we will continue to look at sentence punctuation as well as using suffixes correctly.
