Maths

History and Geography

This term we will be looking at Antarctica. We will be learning where Antarctica is, its weather conditions and its inhabitants. We will then compare this to the Arctic using our previous learning. In History we will be learning about Scott's journey to the South Pole and his race with Amundsen to discover the South Pole first.

RE

In RE we will be learning about the Easter story and its importance of Easter to the Christian faith. We will learn about the events leading up to the crucifixion of Jesus and how people celebrate Easter today.

English

Science

This term we are identifying and naming polar animals and how they are suited to their habitat. We will also learn about how they source their food.

In DT this term we are creating a diorama for our clay animals. We will use different paper techniques to create moving parts and to create a stand for their animal.
