# COSTUME IDEAS

## Boys

Open necked shirt with a scarf tied around the neck.

Trousers cut off at knees or tucked into socks.

Waistcoat or similar.

Boots or shoes.

Flat cap.



## Girls

Long skirt or petticoat.

Blouse - school blouse turned back to front and buttoned down the back.

Apron.

Shawl.

Mop cap.

Boots or shoes.

Costumes need to be very basic, remember the children are servants and are to be working.
