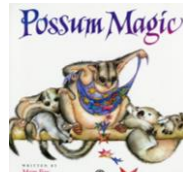
Term 6 2021-2022

This term our theme is:  
**Australia**

## Maths

This term in maths we begin with measure. Year 1 children will investigate measures using non-standard units of measures, for example how many cubes or paperclips, before moving onto standard units of measure. Year 2 children will go straight to standard units of measure. This is followed by telling the time.

## History and Geography

The children will continue their learning all about Australia. This term the children will learn about Australia being a member of the Commonwealth. They will focus on Queen Elizabeth's role as head of state. The children will learn about how rules are created in Australia and the democracy they live in and how this is similar to our democracy. The children will learn that Australia is split into 6 states, the names of the states and that each state can make their own laws.

## RE

The children will explore how people are treated. They will learn from religious stories and beliefs around helping those less fortunate. The children will also learn about significant people who have helped others in their lives.

## English

In English our first-class text is Possum Magic by Mem Fox. The children will be using this for both their writing and reading lessons. We will be spending the final term cementing the key skills of sentence writing, including punctuation and conjunctions through this text. In our reading lessons we will have a focus on retrieval and inference skills.

## Science

The children will learn the difference between things that are alive, are dead and things that have never been alive. They will name habitats and the animals that live in them and sort animals according to their habitats. They will also construct food chains.

## Art

The children will be exploring the different portraits of the Queen that have been produced over the years before creating their own versions based on a famous artist.
