EYFS Forecast Sheet Term 6 2023



This term our theme is:

'In the Garden'

Mathematics

This term we will be consolidating our understanding of numbers to 20. We will learn about odd and even numbers, doubling, grouping and sharing, using this knowledge to help us solve problems. Later on in the term, we will consolidate our understanding of patterns and continue to work on solving problems

Expressive art and design

We will be using all we have learnt to create pictures, models, songs and dances. We will talk about our ideas, the features of our work and how we might improve it. We will make sure we can use a variety of tools safely and choose the appropriate technique to achieve what we want.

Understanding the World

Our learning will focus on the garden environment. We will plant seeds and beans, look at the conditions needed to grow plants and compare environments around the world that grow different types of fruit or vegetables. We will also learn about the life cycle of a butterfly in more detail, following on from last term.

Literacy

This term our writing will be inspired by stories focusing on plants and minibeasts. We will sequence stories using the language of time, create fact files and write sentences to describe different life cycles. As always, we will continue to develop our phonic knowledge in our daily lessons.

Physical Development

This term in gymnastics, we will be working on the fundamentals of movement; agility, balance and coordination. In preparation for Sports Day, we will try different racing events and practise managing our feelings when winning or losing. With our handwriting we will continue to work on letter formation and sitting letters on the line.

PE will continue be on a **<u>Friday</u>** for both classes. Please make sure that your child has a water bottle (not juice) in school.

Reading and The Library

Please try and read with your child at least 5 times a week. The children receive a dojo for each read they do at home. They also receive a raffle ticket for every 5 reads they complete. At the end of the term they then have a chance to win a book in the reading raffle. You must record your child's reads in their reading record.

We will continue to visit the library on a Wednesday. Please send your child in with their library book on this day.
