We also have a Family Support Worker at Hawthorn called Mrs Brown. Mrs Brown's role is to support families in times of difficulty, so please ask for help should you need it. Mrs Brown will be able to support and signpost around areas such as attendance, behaviour, housing, finance, mental or physical health. In addition, we have a Designated Safeguarding Lead (Mrs Jacox) and several deputy DSLs in school (Mrs Martin, Mrs Brown, Miss Blakeley and Mrs O'Key), who will be able to help, should you have any safeguarding concerns.

# Attendance

Hawthorn strives to work with parents to ensure children have excellent attendance at school. Regular school attendance is crucial for your child's success and social development. We aim for all children to maintain an attendance figure of 96%. Of course, we are aware that children fall ill from time to time, but we will continue reporting your child's attendance to you on a termly basis so that you can keep track of their percentage. Please note that we are unable to authorise holidays taken in term time and you may be subject to a fine issued by the Local Authority. If you need any support regarding attendance, please contact school and we will do what we can to support you.

# **Drop off and Collection**

Reception and KS1 (Y1 & Y2):

- Children should enter via the Hawthorn Road gate which will open at 8.30am and close at 8.45am.
- Reception and KS1 children should be collected at 3.15pm, from the Hawthorn gate (Reception) and the Broadway entrance playground (Y1 & Y2).

KS2 (Y3-6)

- Children should enter via the Broadway gates which will open at 8.30am. The whistle will be blown at 8.40am and the gates will close at 8.45am.
- KS2 children will finish at 3.20pm and should be collected from the BroadwayNDER gate.

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The register will be taken at 8.50am with morning work starting at this time. If your child is late for school, they will miss important elements of our curriculum.

## **School Values**

As we go into the new school year, we will be reminding our children to promote our school values. Hawthorn has six school values which are:

- Community
- Teamwork
- Resilience
- Creativity
- Respect
- Thoughtfulness

These values are important at Hawthorn because they focus on preparing our children to become well-rounded citizens as they move through the school and beyond. We will be focusing on one of these values each half term. The children will gain a good understanding of what the value means and how to live it out. This term, our value is Community. We will be talking to our children about the importance of being part of our Hawthorn community, but also what it means to be part of our wider community. Please talk with your child about what a community means to them and if they have any examples of how they have been active in their local community, we would love to see or hear about it.

#### Uniform

A reminder that we expect all children to be dressed in full school uniform, including the correct PE kit on PE days.
