KS1 Forecast

## Term 1 2023-24

This term our theme is: Nurturing Nurses

#### History

In History, the children will learn about the life of significant individuals from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements. This term, we will learn about the nurse Mary Seacole who travelled to the Crimea to set up the British Hotel hospital in order to care for sick and injured soldiers. The children will learn about the plants she used to treat their illnesses and how her actions have had a positive impact on nursing today.

Maths

This term in maths all children begin with place value. In Year 1 children will consolidate their learning of numbers from EYFS by counting, sorting and ordering. In Year 2 children will be counting objects to 100 by grouping into tens and learning to partition numbers into tens and ones.

### RE

This term the children will learn about what life is like for a Christian. They will find out about the Bible and learn some stories about Jesus. They will explore common practices you may find in a Christian household and how special times, such as weddings, are celebrated by Christians.

### Art

In art, the children will focus on developing their drawing skills and using different lines to show texture. They will use a range of media and materials and use their observation skills to identify shapes and draw accurately.

#### English

In English Year 1 will be using the story of The 3 Little Pigs to inspire their own traditional tale. They will practise writing sentences that begin with a capital letter and end with a full stop. In Year 2 the text is The Hospital Dog. The children will practise writing parts of the story before writing their own story about an animal that visits the hospital.

Science

The children will learn to name the basic parts of the human body and will think about what their body parts will do. The children will also learn about ways to keep their body healthy, including hygiene and healthy eating.
