### AUTUMN TERM- WHAT'S HAPPENED IN OUR PRIMARY SCHOOLS TO SUPPORT PUPILS?

EFFECTIVE MATHS

We've standardised our way of teaching mathematics fluency from Y1-6 with an additional 1hr maths lesson per week. We know this will help our pupils secure greater fluency which will enable them to reach their full potential and be secondary ready.

PiXL aims to support schools to improve life chances and outcomes for pupils by identifying gaps in knowledge and supporting pupils in their progress






Read Write Inc is a popular phonics scheme that teaches children the sounds in English, the letters that represent them, and how to form the letters when writing. It includes reading books written using only the letters the children have learnt at each level (and a small number of separately taught tricky words). It helps children quickly feel confident in their reading.

Our Primary Schools will be provided with some exceptional training and resources for Talk for Writing and Talk for Reading over the next 18 months. This work will support our schools in delivering high quality writing and reading curriculums. We'll also be holding development days at every school to support staff and leaders further.
