Literacy

We will continue to use our phonic knowledge in our reading and writing. We will write labels and captions and sentences. We will also develop our understanding of rhyme and alliteration and learn how to form questions.





PE will continue to be on a **Tuesday** for Cherries and Apples. Please come to school in your PE uniform.

Maths

This term we will continue to work on recognising and ordering numbers to 5 and then 10. We will be using our knowledge of number to explore calculations by finding pairs of numbers that equal different numbers to 10. We will also practise finding 1 more/less than different numbers.

Library

We will continue to visit the library on a **Wednesday**. Please ensure your book is returned each week so that a new one can be issued.

Understanding the World

We will be learning about the life of Mary Anning, and how she found fossils of prehistoric animals. We will also be learning about what Lunar New Year is. We will look at the importance of this festival to some people and make comparisons between this and how Christmas is celebrated. In Science, we will be looking at what we can see, here and feel when we are outside. We will discuss the changing nature of the seasons and what this means to us.

Expressive arts and design

This Term we will explore paint and painting techniques through nature, music and collaborative work. The children will explore creativity through child-led exploration of mixed media, making collages and transient art.

During our Chinese New Year celebrations, we will explore the music and dance of this country and perform our own Lion Dance.

Our PE lessons this term will focus on Gymnastics where we will learn to move our bodies in a controlled way. We will also perform dances and study healthy and unhealthy food.
