KS1 Forecast

Term 3 2023-24

This term our theme is:
Frozen Lands

Maths

All children will learn about 2D and 3D **Shapes** including how to identify them from their different properties. In Year 2, children will then focus on **Money**, learning to recognise coins and notes and finding total amounts.

Our next unit will be **Place Value**. In Year 1, children will focus on reading and writing with numbers to 70 and counting in 1s and 2s. The Year 2 children will focus on counting in 10s, 5s and 3s, as well as ordering and comparing numbers. Finally, we will move on to our **Calculation** skills. In Year 1, children will concentrate on adding and subtracting with numbers up to 20 and in Year 2, they will learn to add and subtract with both 1-digit and 2-digit numbers using the column method.

English

In English the children will start the term by learning how to write instructions. They will identify the features of instruction writing before having a go at writing their own. Next the children will learn the story *Kassim and the Dragon*. They will spend time retelling the story in different ways before writing their own version of the story. The children will also practise their handwriting regularly.

Science

Our topic is *Everyday Materials*. The children will explore a range of materials such as wood, metal and plastic, and learn about their different properties. They will then use this knowledge to carry out an investigation and sort them.

Geography

This term in *Geography* we are learning about frozen lands. The children will learn the location of The Arctic and Antarctica and find these on a map. They will explore the conditions of these locations such as the temperature and the weather and how global warming might impact these locations. The children will learn about the physical features of each location and they will also find out about the transport and homes in cold climates and compare these to the UK.

RE

In RE this term we are learning about what life is like for a Muslim family. We will learn about what a mosque is and how Muslims use a mosque. We will find out about Allah and why he is important to Muslims, as well as learning about the 5 pillars.

Art

Our focus is *Sculpture*. The children will learn how to roll and shape paper and learn how to attach these to a base to form an imaginative 3D sculpture. They will also work collaboratively as a group to plan and create another sculpture, and apply their painting skills to decorate it.
