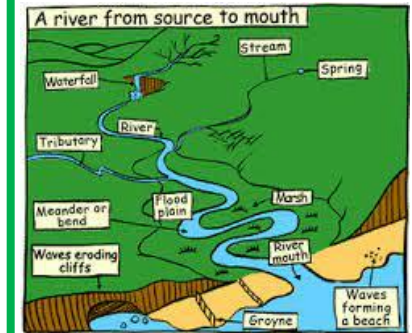
Growing Artists
