KS1 Forecast

Term 6 2023-24

This term our theme is:
The Beach and Hunstanton

Maths

In **Year 1** we will begin by adding larger numbers. We will then work with numbers up to 80 learning about partitioning 80, 90 and 100. We will then learn about multiplication and division, making equal groups and working on multiplication stories. After this we will move on to fractions and learn about halves and quarters. We will learn about time, finding out how to tell the time to one hour and to half an hour and the vocabulary needed for time. Later in the term we will revisit money and adding and subtracting amounts of money before learning about patterns and relationships.

In **Year 2** we will start the term looking at adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing with different amounts of money. We will then move on to learning about measures. This will involve estimating, measuring, and comparing lengths in centimetres and metres. We will also learn about mass and volume, through measuring and comparing in grams, kilograms, litres, and millimetres. We will then finish the year, looking at patterns and relationships.

English

In English the children will be learning the story Billy's Beetle. This is a losing tale. The children will be learning how to use adjectives to describe character and objects as well as the impact that verbs can have in a story. We will create a description toolkit which will help to guide our writing. At the end of the term the children will write their own losing tale.

Science

This term, our topic is animals including humans. We will learn that all animals have offspring, either giving birth to live young or laying eggs. We will look at lifecycles and how young animals change as they grow into adulthood. We will also look at the importance of a balanced diet, good hygiene habits and exercising in having a healthy body.

Geography

This term in Geography we will be mainly learning about the seaside. We will start off by recapping the four countries of the UK plus their capital cities. We will locate the coast on a map and name the surrounding seas.

We will locate Kettering and Hunstanton on a map and discuss the similarities and differences between the two localities. When learning about the seaside we will name features of the seaside and sort these features into human or physical. We will also think about the pros and cons with living at the seaside or in-land.

RE

This term we are learning about how we can care for others around us and the world and why this is important. The children will learn about how people in the Christian and Muslim faith give to others.

They will find out about the work of Mother Theresa and Dr Barnardo. Finally, children will learn about the importance of the 3rd Pillar of Islam to Muslims and what Zakat is. We will link this to the importance of having friends and to the school value for this term. thoughtfulness.

DT

Our topic will be Moving Vehicles. We will look at the main parts of a vehicle and learn technical language such as chassis, axle and engine as well as explore ways of joining them together. This will help us to plan and make our own moving vehicle before finally evaluating our product.
