Uniform

As many of you will be thinking of purchasing new school uniform over the summer holidays, I wanted to remind you of our uniform expectations here at Hawthorn.

We consider it important that our pupils feel a sense of belonging to our school and wearing a smart and practical uniform allows all children, regardless of their backgrounds, to feel equal to their peers and confident in their appearance.

Our uniform at Hawthorn consists of:

- Bottle-green jumper or cardigan, with or without the school logo
- White shirt, blouse or polo-shirt, with or without the school logo
- Grey trousers, skirt or pinafore dress
- Black school shoes (no trainers)

Summer options:

- Grey shorts
- Green and white summer dress

Our PE Uniform:

- Plain white t-shirt, with or without the school logo
- Plain black shorts or skort
- Plain black jogging bottoms or leggings
- Plain black hoodie, with or without the school logo
- Black trainers

A reminder that jewellery, with the exception of stud earrings, is not allowed in school. Earrings must be removed for PE and swimming days. Hair-styles should be tidy and not brightly coloured and nail varnish and tattoo transfers are not permitted.

All school uniform can be purchased from [KS Schoolwear](#) (with logo) Unit 7, Trafalgar Road, Kettering NN16 8DB, or through [My Clothing](#). Uniform in the correct colours without a logo may also be purchased from supermarkets or other suppliers. If you are in receipt of the Pupil Premium voucher, this can be used to pay for uniform. A second-hand uniform stall operated by the Friends of Hawthorn is open throughout the school year for parents to purchase uniform at a minimum cost. Details are sent out via Dojo/MCAS.

Lockers (KS2)

If your child is in KS2 they will have a locker in which to store their school bags and coats. Please make sure any bag that your child brings to school is no bigger than 37cm x 24cm, otherwise it will not fit in the lockers. There is no need to bring large pencil cases into school as we will provide your child with all the stationery they need.
