KS1 Forecast

Term 1 2024-25

This term our theme is:
Let's Explore London

Maths

In **Year 1** we will begin by recapping counting and writing numbers. We will practice number formation and simple number facts like number bonds and one more and one less. We will then move on to place value where we will read and write two-digit numbers and begin counting forwards and backwards in twos.

We will learn about calculation and number bonds from 5 to 10 and solve problems with these facts. At the end of the term, we will then learn the related subtraction facts for these numbers.

In **Year 2** we will start by recapping number bonds and related facts to 10 and 20. We will then move onto place value of numbers to 100 and learn how to partition numbers into tens and ones. We will round off the term by learning to add and subtract a two-digit number and ones.

English

We will be learning the story of The 3 Bears using actions. We will innovate on the story by changing the characters and writing a new version together. We will then have a go at planning and writing our own story using the same structure as The 3 Bears. At the end of the term we will start our non-fiction unit of work on instructions.

Science

We will learn that there are 4 seasons in a year: spring, summer, autumn and winter. We will then focus on autumn and find out what the weather is like and how some trees lose their leaves. We will go on a walk to spot signs of autumn and will find out how some animals prepare for the colder weather which is on its way.

Geography

We will name and locate the 4 countries of the United Kingdom, as well as the capital cities and surrounding seas. We will use aerial photographs to identify London landmarks and learn about the human and physical features of London.

RE

In RE we will be learning about Harvest, Thinksgiving and Eid-UI-Adha. We will find out about different religious festivals, why they are important and how they are celebrated before comparing them. We will also have the opportunity to celebrate our own Harvest Festival.
