KS1 Forecast

Term 2 2024-25

This term our theme is:
The Great Fire of London

Maths

Year 1 - we will continue to learn to subtract this term, recapping our number bonds and solving subtraction problems. Later in the term we will learn about 2D and 3D shapes and patterns with these shapes. We will then move onto our money unit where we will learn to recognise coins and solve money problems.

Year 2 - we will continue with calculations, learning how to add and subtract with or from multiples of 10. We will then move onto multiplication and learn our 2, 5 and 10x tables and the related division facts. After that we will learn how to read the time before moving onto recognising and ordering simple fractions.

English

We will start the term focusing on non-fiction by learning how to write instructions. We will learn the importance of sequencing instructions and what time adverbials could be used to start each instruction. At the end of the term we will learn a new story, *The Magic Porridge Pot*, which we will innovate before writing our own version.

Science

In science we will be learning about materials and their uses. We will recap properties then explore what happens to different materials when they are bent, squashed, twisted and stretched. We will find out why materials are used to make certain objects before carrying out 2 investigations to find the most suitable material for different jobs.

History

We will learn about the events of the *Great Fire of London* including when, where and why it happened. We will find out what the houses of London were like during this time and how this contributed to such a devastating fire. We will discover who Samuel Pepys was and how he famously kept a diary which is why we know about the event today! We will also find out about the new rules which were followed when rebuilding London so that such horrific events did not repeat themselves.
