History and Geography

This term we will be learning all about the Great Fire of London. We will use the book 'The Great Fire of London' by Emma Adams and James Weston Lewis. We start by learning about London in the 17thC. We will learn about how the fire started and how it was able to spread so quickly. We will then move onto learning about the changes that were made after the fire to stop it from happening again.
